

## Ford Rear Crankshaft Seal Installer

Applications : 1993–'97 Aerostar; 1993–'04 Ranger and Explorer w/ 4.0L V6 engine

Crankshaft rear oil seals used on the above vehicles are available with or without a metal wear sleeve; tool No. 7834 will work on both types.



CAUTION: To prevent personal injury, wear eye protection that meets ANSI Z87.1 and OSHA standards.

- 1. Remove the old rear crankshaft seal (and wear ring, if applicable), and clean the crankshaft sealing surface.
- 2. Attach the adapter (from No. 7834) to the crankshaft using the supplied bolts. See Figure 1.
- 3. Install the new seal as shown in Figure 2:

## **Seal with Wear Sleeve**

Note: If the new rear crankshaft seal includes a wear sleeve, do NOT remove it. Install the seal and wear sleeve together.

- A. Lightly oil the crankshaft and the adapter assembled in Step 2.
- B. Place the seal & wear sleeve assembly on the adapter.
- C. Place the installer over the seal/wear sleeve, and install the bolt.

## **Seal without Wear Sleeve**

- A. Place the seal protector over the adapter assembled in Step 2.
- B. Lightly oil the seal protector.
- C. Place the seal on the seal protector.
- D. Place the installer over the seal, and install the bolt.
- 4. Tighten the bolt on the installer to pull the seal assembly over the crankshaft and into the cylinder block. See Figures 3 and 4. **IMPORTANT**: To prevent damage to the seal, do not use air tools to pull the seal into place.
- 5. Remove the installer, protector, and adapter.






